

GUIDELINES FOR DELHI TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY CORPUS FUND

Higher education including Technical Education in India is mainly funded by the government through Grant in Aid or budgetary support. With the expansion of higher education as well as to improve the quality of education through better infrastructure and other facilities the fund requirements in future will increase. The world over, including India, many institutions have established the Corpus Fund in order to generate funding from sources other than GIA and also to meet the needs of funds of the university.

Therefore, building of a corpus fund is important, in order to ensure smooth sustenance of university. Though, core activities of the university will continue with the help of University Generated Fund, Grant-in-Aid from Government, creation of corpus fund is envisaged by Delhi Technological University Act 2009 for specific purpose and it will be generated from different sources. Delhi Technological University Corpus Fund may involve contributions from alumni, parents businesses, Corporates, professionals, and friends in building up a strong financial base for the purpose of extending support to young talents to achieve their dreams without any financial constraints.

A Objectives of the Fund

- 1. To enlarge the resource base by mobilizing participation of society
- 2. To evolve a process for the participation of Society in the University development
- 3. To develop the best human resource for teaching and research activities in the University
- 4. To create research infrastructure
- 5. To support in enhancing healthy and motivating environment in the University
- 6. To create and modernize facilities in the University

B Sources

 - b) For research and higher studies
 - c) For innovative projects
 - d) For enhancing incubation facility
 - e) For Research and/or Teaching Assistantship
- 8. Any other purpose in the interest of University with the approval of BOM.



Guidelines for Instituting Medals and Scholarship

DTU invites Individuals, Societies & Foundations to institute Medals & Scholarship to inspire the students. In this regard, DTU has crafted guidelines for initiating such medals and scholarships. From next year onwards a student shall be awarded only one scholarship/medal. In case student is found to be eligible for more then one scholarship/medal, he/she shall be awarded higher amount scholarship/medal and the other shall be awarded to next eligible student.

The criteria for award of Medals/Scholarship can be decided by the donor, however an indicative list is given below:

- a. Overall topper in the University
- b. Overall topper of a particular year/semester
- c. Topper of a branch overall
- d. Topper of a branch in a particular year
- e. Topper of a particular subject/ project/ industrial training
- f. Best sports person Male/Female
- g. It could be also for a particular category of student viz. general/ reserved/ PWD.

The guiding principles for instituting Medals/Awards/Scholarship at DTU:

Scholarship

Duration	5 Years
Minimum amount	₹ 60,000/- per year
Amount to be deposited	Full amount of 5 years at the time of institution of scholarship ($₹ 60,000 \times 5 = ₹ 3,00,000/-)$
Disbursement	Every month (₹ 60,000 / 12 = ₹ 5,000/- per month)
	The donor should specify the criteria for award in terms of branch, year, means or merit and also give name/ title of scholarship.

Medals

Duration	10 Years
Amount to be deposited	₹5,00,000/-

- Medal shall be preferably of 100 gms silver with gold plating.
- The medal shall have DTU logo on one side and donor's inscription on the reverse side.
- The medalist shall receive medal and citation at the time of convocation or any date decided by the university along with a cash incentive of ₹ 40,000

CLASS OF 1969 SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship was instituted by the alumni under Association of 1969 Civil Engineering Batch of erstwhile DCE. The Association was registered in 2002. Its main purpose and work over the years has been starting and sustaining a benevolent fund for providing scholarships to meritorious and/or needy students.
