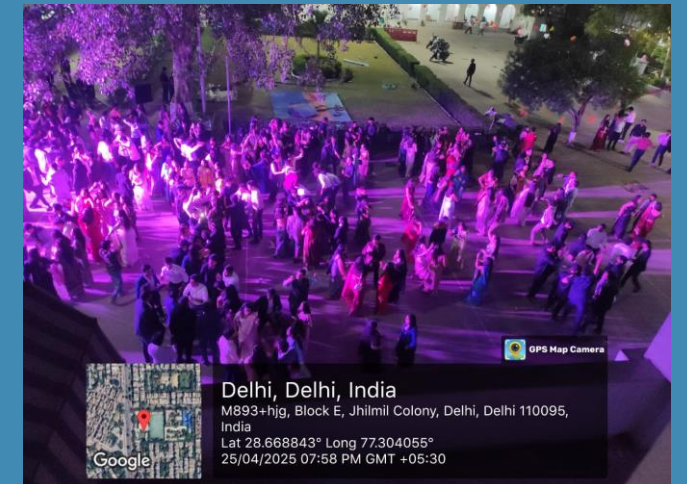
It served as a symbolic closure to their college journey, leaving everyone with personalized tokens of friendship and memories.

The initiative promoted **ethical responsibility and integrity**, inspiring students to commit to a **corruption-free society**.

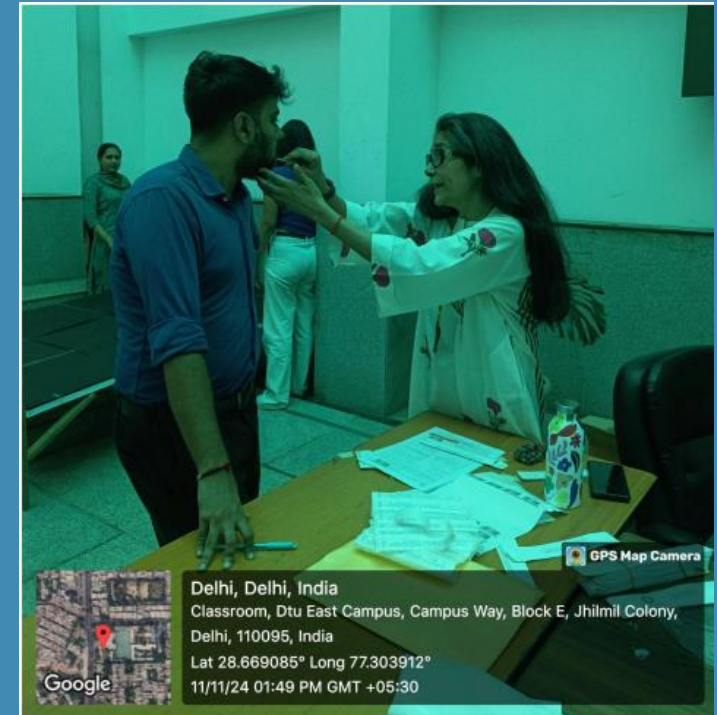
BLOOD STEM CELL DONATION AWARENESS & REGISTRATION DRIVE

12th September 2024

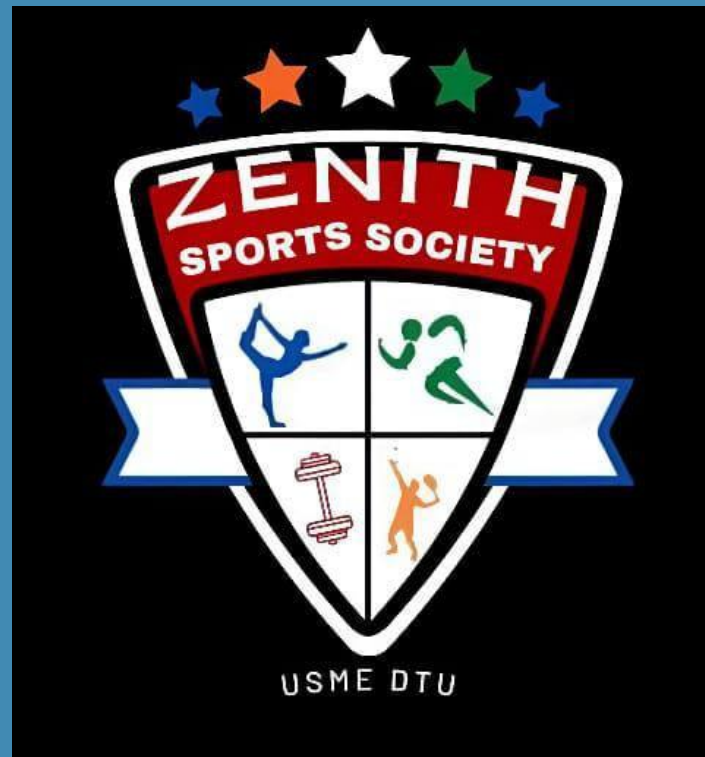

Two teams from the society re-enacted famous scenes from popular films, demonstrating their acting skills and passion for theatre.

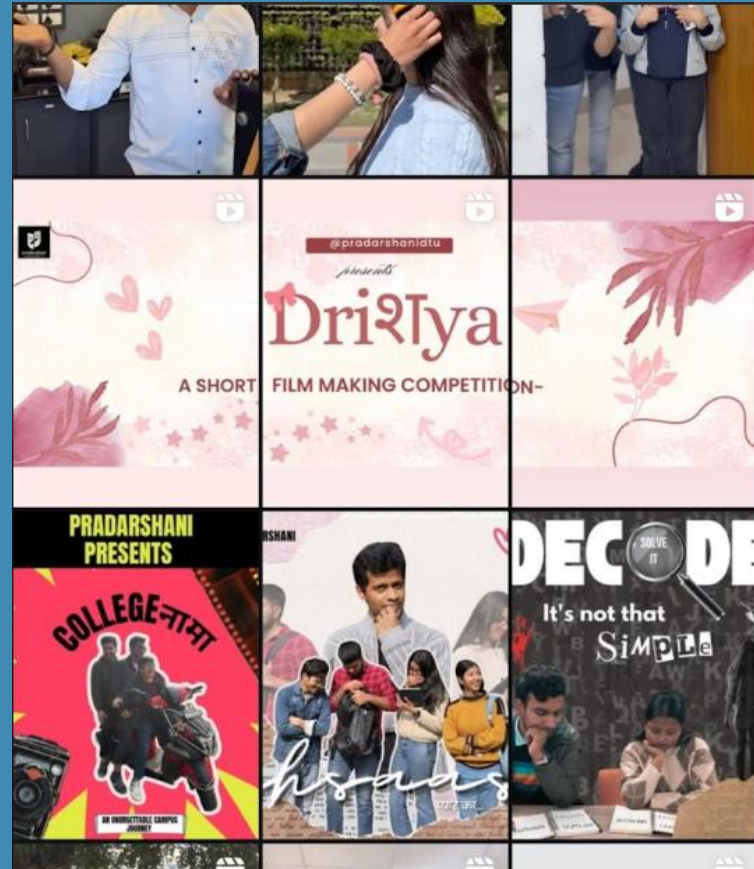


DRISHYA

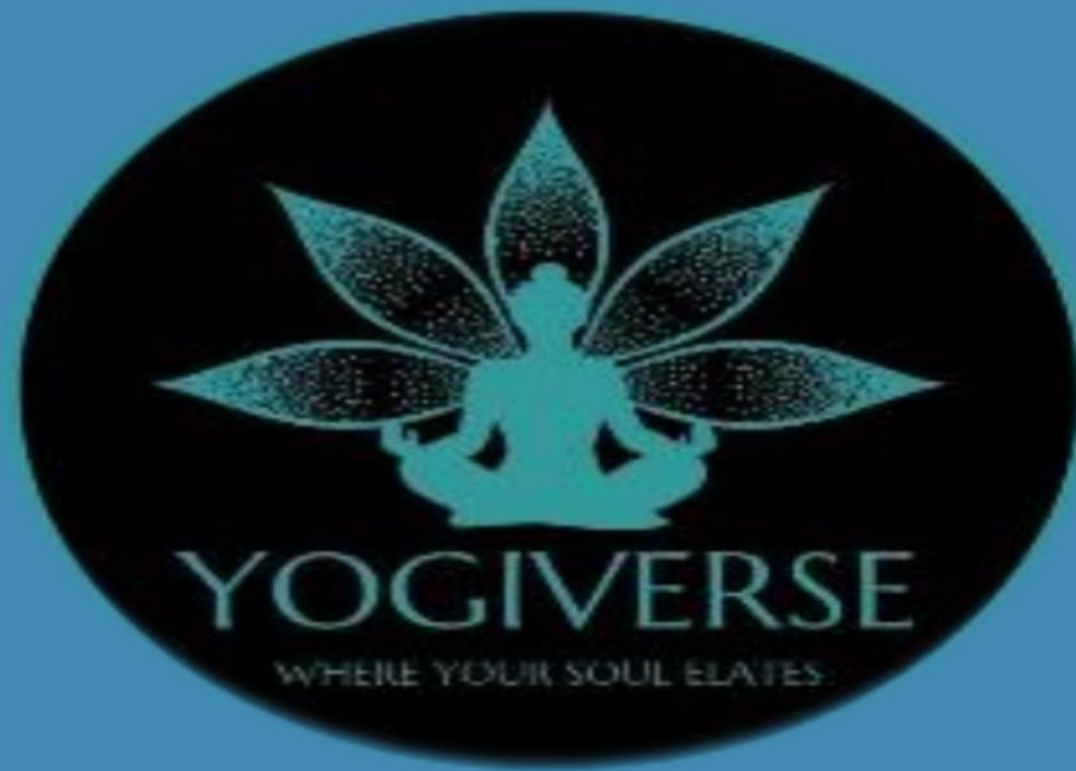
SAFARNAMA

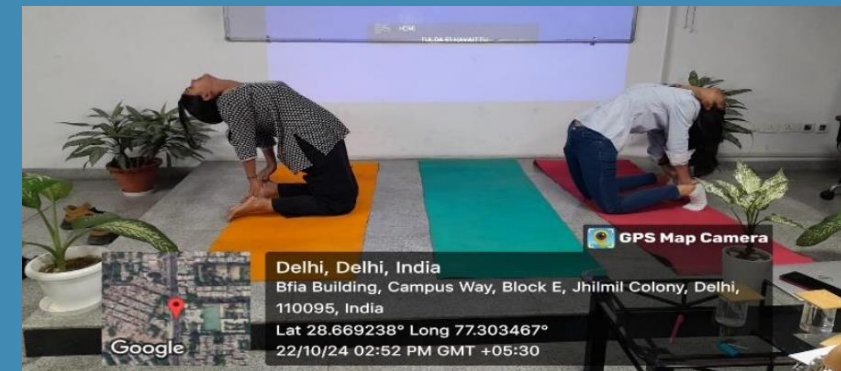
YOGA FOR STRESS MANAGEMENT AND MENTAL CLARITY

25th October 2024

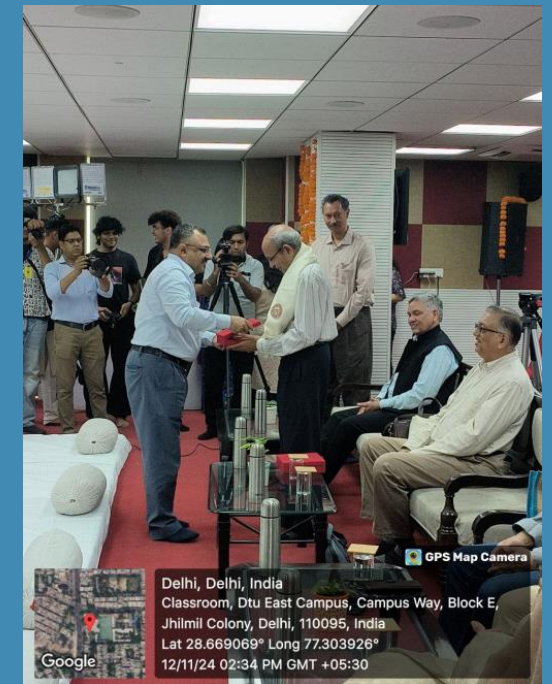

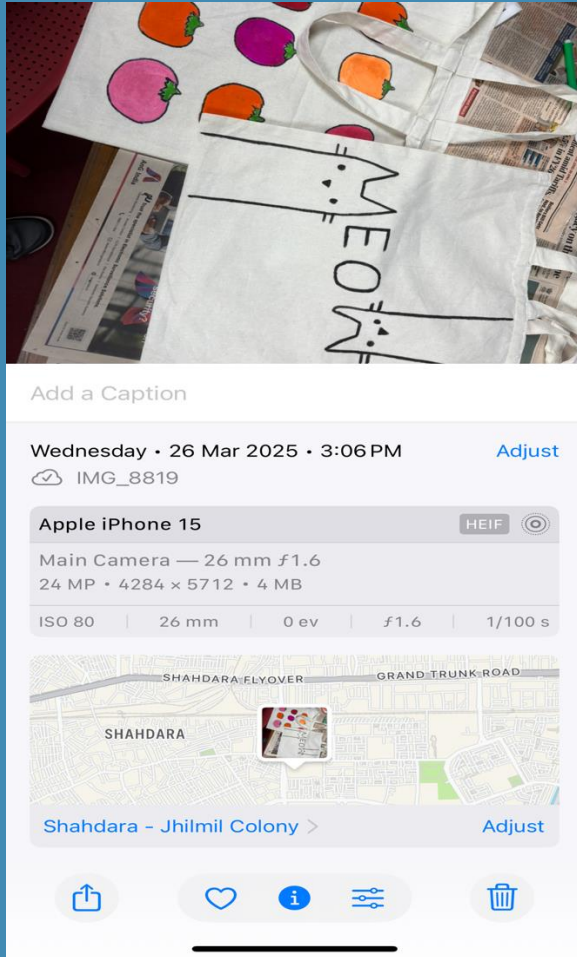


HUED - THE TOTE BAG PAINTING EVENT BY AESTHETIC

STARTUP BAZAAR & PINTEREST DAY



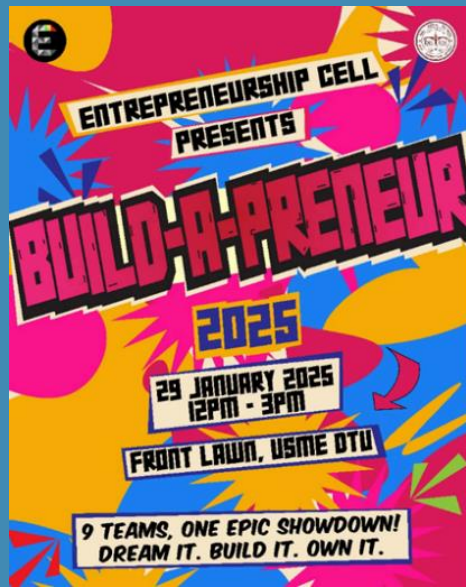
15th October 2024

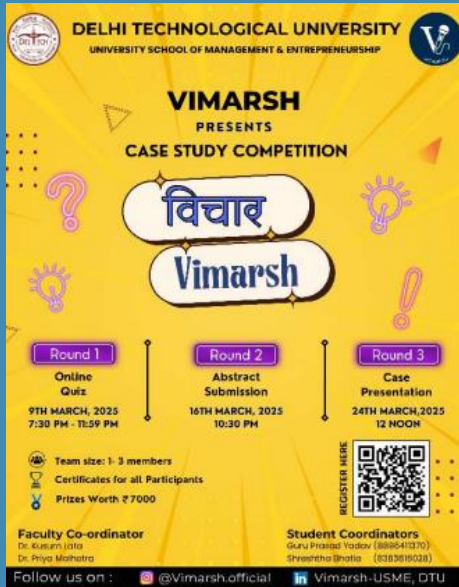

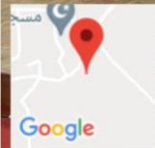
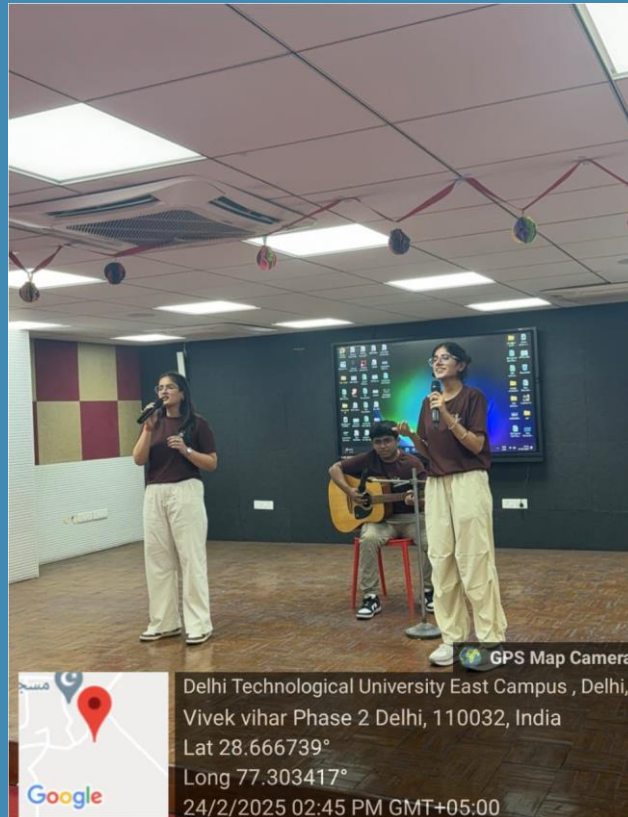
