Design & Siml., Backend Dev., Flutter Dev., UI Design, BioTech Research, Marketing and Research, ML AI Programmer, Content Creator, Front End Dev., Full Stack Dev., Embedded Soft., Android Dev., Web Dev., React JS Dev.,

The University has also launched the project Lab on Wheels under Centre for Extension and Field Outreach (OEA). The Lab on Wheels is a customized bus and house 16 computers, two big size TVs, one 3D Printer, ACs, Cameras and one common use printer. It is expected that USIP interns in this project shall empower under privileged and diversified sections of the society to enhance their educational standard, digital literacy and learning skills by teaching them such as Basic Computer Course (BCC) and Basic Python Programming (BPP), U

The student interns are required to work for minimum eight hours a week including weekends and holidays, and will be paid Rs. 3500/- per month on successful completion.

It is now planned to select interns for next round tentatively in first or second week of August, 2025.
