Particulars of recipients of concessions, permits or authorizations granted

[Section 4(1)(b)(xiii)]

CASH PRIZES, MEDALS & CERTIFICATES OF MERIT

1. The prizes and medals will be awarded annually to the students securing the first and second position, separately for each year (either combining the respective semesters of an year or the concerned year itself) of the concerned programme till the completion of the end year/ end semester of each academic programme being conducted in University.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The University gives Scholarships per annum to the students admitted in the University in order of merit of the Common Admission Test (CAT) to the first three students admitted in each programme. These Scholarships shall be awarded after the first semester examinations. These Scholarships will continue till these students complete their studies provided they continue to secure minimum of 60% marks in both the Semesters taken together in the subsequent years of the concerned programmes.

i. Every student admitted to M.Tech. full time Programme will be awarded a Scholarship of Rs. 8000/- p.m from the date of admission or commencement of instructions whichever is later, for a maximum period of 24 months subject to the rules made in this respect. Qualifying in GATE is essential. These students will be required to undertake 8 to 10 hours per week related to teaching and research activity as assigned to him by the institute. This could include tutorials, laboratory classes, development and maintenance of laboratories, assistance in research and

development activities undertaken by faculty members, maintenance and operation of computers and other central facilities, assistance in library etc. They are also entitled to Rs.8,000/- contingent grant per annum.

ii. Every student admitted to Ph.D. full time Programme will be awarded a Scholarship of Rs. 14,000/- for science & Engineering. if he holds M.Sc degree, from the date of admission, for a maximum period of 48 months subject to the rules made in this respect. These students will be required to undertake teaching assistance of B.E. classes to a maximum extent of 8 to 10 hours per week. They are also entitled to annual contingent grant of Rs.17,500 P.M. (provided by IRD Cell)

RESERVATION

Reservation policy for the year 2010-11 would be notified on the website www.dce.edu.

I) 3% seats in post graduate program will be reserved for candidates with physical disability. These reservation will be implemented department wise in post graduate courses. Candidates seeking admission as detailed in eligibility conditions except relaxation of 5% marks in the minimum eligibility conditions. The 3% reservation may be allocated as follows: 1% for person with low vision or blindness: 1% for hearing impaired: 1% for those with locomotor disabilities and or cerebral palsy.

II) In the M.Tech. Programs one Defense Research & Development Organization sponsored candidate to each Program duly selected through DRDO selection interviews, which are participated in by the respective Heads of Departments, will be accommodated in the list of candidates under sponsored category.
