Agenda 42.1 : Opening remarks by the Vice Chancellor.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Board and particularly to Dr. SB Deepak Kumar on his joining as Secretary, Training and Technical Education & Higher Education, Government of NCT of Delhi. Vice Chancellor explained about importance of meeting being conducted within a month of earlier meeting, to make provision of providing fund for retirement benefits to the employees of DTU. He further explained that in view of starting of new academic session 2021-22 w.e.f. August 2021, various admission committees for the purpose of admission to UG and PG programmes have been framed. He further informed that University is maintaining section of size 70 students in a class, for teaching purpose (60 + 10 supernumerary).

He informed that University has developed a "Lab on Wheels" which is Wi-Fi enabled laboratory and providing hands-on experience on different software/ teaching material/ videos. DTU has adopted 5 villages and providing teaching to 15 schools in the vicinity of the University. The "Lab on Wheels" will be inaugurated by Chief Guest Deputy Chief Minister and Education Minister, Delhi Sh. Manish Sisodia on 6th April 2021 at 11 A.M. Dr. SB Deepak Kumar, Secretary, Training and Technical Education & Higher Education, Government of NCT of Delhi will be the Guest of Honour on this occasion. Sh. Udit Prakash Rai, Director, Education, Government of Delhi will also grace the occasion as special guest. This will be followed by the inauguration of new building of the Department of Design and Class Room Complex. The Vice Chancellor invited all the members of the Board to join the event on stipulated date and time.

Agenda 42.4 : Provision for Retirement Benefits to Delhi Technological University employees.

It was submitted to the Board of Management that during Entrustment of Annual Accounts Audit by AGCR it was pointed out that DTU has not made any provision of Retirement benefit i.e, Gratuity and Leave Encashment on the basis of actuarial valuation in the provisional Comments on the Audit for the FY 2017-18 as describe below.

As per Accounting Standard 15, the enterprise should actuarially determine and provide the accrued liability in respect of Defined Employees Benefit Plans (Leave Encashment, Gratuity and Pension). Further, the Format of Financial Statement for Higher Educational Institutions prescribed by Department of Higher Education. Ministry of Human Resource Development also prescribes provision of Retirement benefit i.e, pension, gratuity and leave encashment on the basis of actuarial valuation. Audit however, noticed that the DTU has not made any such provision. Non provision of liabilities towards employees benefits plans on actuarial basis is in contravention of the requirement of Accounting Standard 15.

Considering the above observation of AGCR Audit, it was proposed in the 23rd meeting of the Finance Committee held on 19.03.2021 that an initial provision Rs. 20 Crore towards retirement benefits to DTU employees covered under New Pension Scheme (NPS) may be made during the current FY 2020-21 for the period FY 2010-11 (inception of DTU) to FY 2020-21 and further provision will be made on yearly basis.

The Finance Committee considered the proposal vide item number 23.4 and recommended to the Board of Management, DTU for keeping the provision of Rs. 20 Crore during the current financial year 2020-21 towards Retirement benefit to DTU employees covered under New Pension Scheme for the period of FY 2010-11 to 2020-21 from the University Generated Fund. Further provision on yearly basis may be kept in Revised Estimates and Budget Estimates every year.

Decision: The Board of Management considered and approved the provision for Retirement Benefits to Delhi Technological University Employees.

Agenda 42.6 : Approval for creation of Teaching Posts in the discipline of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development in the University School of Management and Entrepreneurship at East Campus, New Delhi.

It was submitted to the Board of Management that a proposal has been received from USME, East Delhi Campus, New Delhi for creation of teaching posts in the discipline of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development. USME runs two post graduate programmes i.e. MBA- Family Business and Entrepreneurship and MBA- Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development under this discipline. These two programmes are entirely different from the normal MBA programmes. These courses were started in the Academic Year 2019-20 and now have an intake of 40 students in each programme. The duration of the programmes is two years.

As per latest standard norms of AICTE for MBA programmes, ratio of faculty to students is 1:20 and the cadre ratio is 1:2:6 (Annexure at page 1 and 2).

The total number of students for two MBA courses = 160.
Thus the number of teachers required = 08 (1:20 as per norms)

According to the calculation 08 faculty/teachers are required for running these programmes as given below:

Professors : 01
Associate Professors : 02
Assistant Professors : 05

The matter was placed before the Board of Management for creation of 08 teaching posts in the discipline of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development.

Decision: The Board of Management considered and approved the creation of 08 teaching posts in the disciplines of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development in USME at East Campus, New Delhi.
