The minutes of the meeting are as follows:

Agenda 22.1 : Opening remarks by the Chairman/Vice Chancellor.

The Chairman welcomed all the members of Finance Committee in its 22nd meeting held on 15.01.2021 through online. He informed the members that this year DTU has produced 78 Ph.Ds and total strength of the students is now 13416. In the placement, DTU is doing best amongst the institutions in India. In Times Higher Education Ranking, last year DTU was placed at 1000+ ranking and it has been placed at 801+ in this year. As per the marks given by Times Higher Education Ranking System under citation (53.7 marks). The performance of DTU is very good compared to other institutions of India including IITs and NITs. He put on record thanks to all faculties, staff, students, HoDs & Deans for this achievement.

DTU has produced 1008 research papers during the last year and h.Index of DTU has gone to 79 compared to h.Index of India 634, USA 2000+ and UK 1400. These are the indicators which acknowledge that DTU is now converting from a teaching university to research University.

Agenda 22.2 : Confirmation of the minutes of 21st meeting of the Finance Committee held on 21.08.2020.

It was submitted to the Finance Committee that Minutes of the 21st meeting of the Finance Committee held on 21.08.2020 were circulated to the Hon'ble members of the Finance Committee vide no F. No.5/AC/ DTU /FC-21/2020/199-207dated 21.08.2020. No comments received from any member of the Finance Committee.

Decision: The Finance Committee confirmed the minutes of its 21st meeting held on 21.08.2020.

Agenda 22.3 : Action taken report on the decisions taken in the 20thmeeting of the Finance Committee held on 21.08.2020.

The Finance Committee was informed that 8 agenda items were discussed in the last meeting held on 21.08.2020. The details of the agenda, decisions taken thereon and the action taken by the University were given in table form for information of the Hon'ble Members.

Decision: The Finance Committee took the Action Taken Report on record.

Agenda 22.4 : Payment of Rs. 2,000/- per student per semester for internet charges for online classes.

It is submitted that the physical classes for all the students are held up due to the current COVID 19 pandemic situation. Studies in the University are being conducted online and all the students for both UG and PG programmes are bearing additional internet charges for attending online classes from their respective homes.

The Academic Council, DTU vide its 25th meeting held on 04.11.2020 (copy of minutes enclosed at page-16) recommended to reimburse Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two thousand only) per student per semester in order to bear additional internet charges. In case the current situation prevails, this facility shall be extended to subsequent semesters. The financial implication of approx. Rs. 2.70 Crore per semester to meet this liabilities and expenditure will be incurred from the Student Welfare Fund.

The Finance Committee is requested to consider the recommendation of Academic Council and approve the proposal for payment of Rs. 2,000/- per student per semester for internet charges for online classes.

Decision: The Finance Committee considered the proposal and recommended to Board of Management, DTU for payment of Rs. 2000/- per student per semester for internet Charges for online Classes for two semester of Academic year 2020-2021.

Agenda 22.5 : Revised Budget Estimates for the Financial Year 2020-2021 and Budget Estimates for the Financial Year 2021-2022.

It is submitted that Rs. 29.00 Crore has been allocated as Grant-in-Aid to DTU for the current Financial Year 2020-21 against the BE of Rs. 416 Crores (296 Cr. GIA + 120 Cr-UGF) approved by the Finance Committee of DTU in its 20th meeting held on 06.12.2019.

The RE 2020-21 and BE 2021-22, has already been sent to the Jt. Director, TTE with the approval of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor/Chairman, Finance Committee, DTU for onward submission to Finance Department, GNCT of Delhi.
