## Notification

In exercise of the powers conferred under Sub-section (2)(b) of section 10 of the Delhi Technological University Act, 2009 (Delhi Act 6 of 2009) of Delhi Technological University the Board of Management in its 32<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 21.06.2019 approved the revised Recruitment Regulations for the Post of Controller of Examinations vide agenda item no. 32.5. 7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment /deputation	<b>Essential</b> 1. Master's degree with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed. 2. At least 15 years of experience as Assistant Professor in the Academic Level-11 or AGP of Rs. 7,000/- and above or with 8 years of service in the Academic Level-12 or AGP of Rs. 8,000/- and above including as Associate Professor along with experience in Educational Administration  OR Comparable experience in research establishment and/or other institutions of higher education.  OR 15 years of administrative experience out of which 08 years shall be as Deputy Registrar or an equivalent post.

		<b>Note:</b> The Controller of Examinations shall hold office for a term of 05 (five) years from the date of which he/she enters upon his/her office and shall be eligible for reappointment for not more than one term or upto age of 60 years whichever is earlier.
