IMPLEMENTATION OF SUMMER SEMESTER FOR, UG & PG PROGRAMS AY-2025-26

Subject: - Guidelines for Summer Semester

The Summer Semester for AY 2025-26 shall commence from 28.05.2026 in accordance with the provision of the Summer Semester as approved by the Academic Council in its 57th meeting held on 12.12.2025, vide Agenda Items No. 57.15. The detailed guidelines for the Summer Semester are as under.

1. Duration

- 1.1 The duration of the summer semester will be 45 days. The academic calendar for Summer Semester AY 2025-26 is enclosed.
- 1.2 Each course will be given contact hours as prescribed in syllabus for that course. The weekly load of a course being offered in the summer semester shall be adjusted to meet the requirement of contact hours prescribed in the syllabus for that course.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 A student is allowed to register in DCC/BSC/ESC/Core/compulsory course (s) only (code have their usual meaning as per scheme).
- 2.2 A student is eligible to register in summer semester for a course if he/she has been awarded F(fail)/D(detained)/W(withdrawal) grade in that course in the current academic year.
- 2.3 A student can register courses in summer semester for maximum of 12 credits. However, if a student's programme curriculum's provision like Summer Training/Industrial Training or similar requirement overlaps with the duration of summer semester, then such a student cannot register in summer semester.
- 2.4 A student will be allowed to appear in the end semester examination of summer semester for the course(s) registered, only if he/she fulfils the attendance criterion for appearing in examination as per regulation R.1 (B).22.
- 2.5 These guidelines shall be applicable to all students of UG & PG programs registering for summer semester irrespective of their batch of admission.
- 2.6 A course will be offered in summer semester only if minimum 20 or 20% of the sanctioned intake students, whichever is less, are registered in the course. All classes will be held in physical mode.

3. Registration

- 3.1 All eligible students intending to pursue courses in Summer Semester must register themselves for the relevant course as per schedule notified by the Examination branch. No late registration shall be permitted on any ground.
- 3.2 A student registering for a course in summer semester will have to pay fee (for each course separately) as per university norms.

4. Course Evaluation

- 4.1 A student will be allowed to appear in the end semester examination of summer semester for the course (s) registered, only if he/she fulfils the attendance criterion for appearing in examination as per regulation R.1 (B).22.
- 4.2 A student shall be evaluated for his/ her academic performance in a course through tutorials, practical's, design studio work, homework, assignments, term papers, seminars, quizzes as CWS, PRS/ STS/ CMS, MTE, ETE/EME and PRE/STE as specified in the Scheme of Teaching and Examination in Academic Programs Ordinance & Regulations
- 4.3 The MTE and ETE will be conducted by as per academic calendar. No makeup examination will be held in a course that is being offered in the summer semester.

Power to remove difficulty: if any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these guidelines, the Vice Chancellor may make such provisions as appeared to be necessary for removing the difficulty.
